

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


## **Redeveloping Dekum Court**

GOAL 5 – Expand economic participation during development – focusing on women and BIPOC communities

- Diversify workforce and increase family wage jobs
  - Apprenticeship and workforce training goals
    - » Pilot increased outreach / support for women and BIPOC community members seeking construction careers (from pre-apprentice to journey level success)
  - Expand Section 3 participation to focus on
    - » Home Forward residents and participants
    - » NE Portland geographic focus in three neighborhoods (Woodlawn, Concordia, Cully)
