What Information Is Shared with the Federal Government?



Once your application for rent assistance or housing with Home Forward is chosen from the waitlist and you complete an application, Home Forward is required to share the following information with the federal government.*

SHARED WITH HUD (Department of Housing and Urban Development)

HUD oversees the Housing Choice Voucher Program. As long as at least one household member has eligible immigration status, the household may receive a Voucher. However, federal rent assistance cannot directly support household members without eligible immigration status. Home Forward is required to share the following information about your household with HUD:

- ✓ For all household members: Name, birth date, income, and employer name/job details
- ✓ Which household members have eligible immigration status & which household members do not claim to have eligible immigration status
- ✓ Social Security numbers or immigration document numbers of household members with eligible immigration status
- \checkmark The address where you rent with your voucher
- ✓ Your rent amount



Home Forward does not directly report to DHS any information about household members who do not claim to have eligible immigration status, but HUD and DHS share information

DHS checks the immigration status of household members with eligible immigration status. Home Forward must share with DHS:

✓ Name, birth date, and immigration document number of all eligible household members

* Home Forward does not any share information with the federal government about people who apply but are not placed on the waitlist.
